## About this list

### Requirement to provide list for tabling

This list of legislative instruments has been prepared for laying before each House of Parliament in accordance with section 52 of the *Legislation Act 2003* (the LA).

This list sets out the legislative instruments that are due to sunset (that is, to be repealed by section 50, 51 or 51A of the LA) on 1 April 2020.

Under subsection 52(2) of the LA, the Attorney-General must arrange for this list to be laid before each House of the Parliament on the first sitting day of the House on or after 1 October 2018.

This list was up-to-date when prepared on 27 August 2018.

### Structure of list

To assist the reader, the instruments are grouped by administering department, consistent with the Administrative Arrangements Order as amended on 10 May 2018.

If a department is not mentioned in the list, the department does not have any legislative instruments due to sunset on 1 April 2020. If 2 or more departments administer a legislative instrument, the instrument is listed under each department and an asterisk (\*) included beside the instrument name.
